

The Fall 2021 MPP entering class includes students from eight countries. Seventeen percent of entering students are international. Of the domestic students, 57% are under-represented minorities and multi-racial, including 42% who identify as Latinx, 11% as African American, and 9% as American Indian, Native Hawaiian, or Pacific Islander. Of the domestic students, 72% are from California. About six of 10 entering students identify as female and four of 10 as male. Over 50% of entering students are first generation college students.
