

How to Download (if needed) to run ArcGIS Pro Locally

DOWNLOAD ARCGISPRO FOR PC

To Download ArcGIS Pro go to: <https://gisucla.maps.arcgis.com/> and log in using your UCLA LOGON credentials.

Click on your profile [Upper Right Corner] and click on MY SETTINGS

Click on LICENSES [left menu side]

Scroll down and click on **DOWNLOAD ArcGIS PRO**

Once completed, double-click on the file you just downloaded and follow the instructions and prompts to install the program.

Note: Some PC users may NEED to update the Microsoft .NET platform. If you get this error during installation, follow the directions below to download the updated version of .NET

Error: ArcGIS Pro requires Microsoft .NET Desktop Runtime (x64). To download and install Microsoft Windows Desktop Runtime - 6.0.5 (x64) or greater, visit the Microsoft Website or contact your system administrator

Download .NET 6.x

Choose .NET Desktop Runtime 6.x for Windows. Most users will choose x64(64bit).

Download the files and install them following the prompts as given.

After installation, re-run the ArcGIS Pro installation file to complete the installation.
